LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT



Dear JCA Family and Friends,

It is with tremendous gratitude that I write this note celebrating the completion of the first Phase: “**Honoring Our Past**” of our Capital Initiative. With this said, we are moving to the second Phase of our campaign which will serve towards “**Building Our Future**”. Through your generous donations and support, we were able to raise \$1.3 million dollars to complete an initiative that brought new windows to the front of our building plus the construction of an area that will celebrate and honor all that the alumni, parents, current students and friends of JCA have done to keep our Traditions alive: **The Heritage Quad**.

Our vision is not complete. For the second Phase of this Capital Initiative, we will be **installing upgraded Wi-Fi** to support our 1:1 Technology program, we will be **completing windows for the back of the building**, and we will be **installing air conditioning in the classrooms** to provide our students with an optimal learning environment. These goals were set from the ideas of our focus groups consisting of parents, alumni, students and friends of JCA. We are set on raising \$1.5 million dollars to complete this initiative, thus giving our students a better JCA.

We truly are Angels and Hillmen, Carmelite and Franciscan! We live the mission of our founding congregations daily and we know that JCA is getting stronger day after day. With your help, we will be able to complete this Phase and move towards future projects. We ask that you consider investing in this vision and more importantly investing in our students.

BUILDING OUR FUTURE

Phase II of the capital initiative, *Building Our Future*, is currently underway. The initiative will involve three major projects, both exterior and interior at the school.

New Windows and Improvements to the Back of Campus

New windows across the front of the building and surrounding Heritage Quad have been completed, resulting in an aesthetic upgrade to the building. Finishing the back of the school will complete the window project, replacing the original windows from St. Francis Academy. The new windows have allowed for greater control of classroom temperatures, a more comfortable learning environment, and increased energy efficiency by 50 percent within the building. Street lamp posts will be added along the back of the campus along Circle Drive and Victory Road, which is being widened with additional parking added. A prayer garden is also being added in order to provide an outdoor opportunity for quiet prayer and reflection for students, staff, family and friends.

Air Conditioning

Coupled with the windows will be the installation of air conditioning throughout the building. Currently, several classrooms have self-contained, ductless air conditioning units. Air conditioning will place our students in an optimal learning environment for our entire school year.

Wi-Fi Infrastructure

Updating our Wi-Fi infrastructure is paramount in preparing for our one-to-one technology initiative set to begin during the 2016-2017 school year. Additionally, each faculty member has received an Acer laptop and training during the 2015-2016 school year to prepare for this initiative. This will allow teachers to integrate the technology into their curriculum to enhance their students' learning. Wi-Fi access points in every classroom will allow for greater signal strength for students and teachers working with their Lenovo laptops utilizing Google Apps for Education. The existing technology infrastructure will be reconfigured with new servers, an upgraded firewall and uniform technology equity in all classrooms.
