### Dear Parent /Guardian,

It is with great anticipation that I welcome you to another school year. We are extremely excited to welcome the Class of 2021 to Joliet Catholic Academy, and also celebrate the accomplishments of the newly minted graduating Class of 2017. The Class of 2017 collectively earned over \$15 million towards college scholarships, performed over 15,000 hours of community service, and achieved a mean ACT score of 24.2 (30.04 in the Honors Program; 27.33 for the top 50% of the class).

What do these numbers signify in context? Over 75% of the Class of 2017 earned a 21 or higher on their ACT, with 98% percent of graduates continuing onto college. For comparison, Illinois' state public school averages of 46% scoring 21 or higher on the ACT, and 68% of graduates continuing onto college provide evidence for the competitive advantage of a Joliet Catholic Academy education.

These numbers reflect not only the outstanding achievement of our student body, but also the sacrifice by our families and community to give JCA students a faith-based education that is second to none.

No doubt the Class of 2017 has left an indelible mark on the halls of JCA, and will venture to do the same for the local community and beyond as they strive toward successful futures.

As we turn the page towards the 2017-2018 school year, I'd like to highlight some important dates this fall, including a change to the typical dates for Open House and the Incoming Freshman Entrance Exam. All Joliet Diocesan Schools will now be testing on December 2, 2017, to give families a head start in the high school decision making process.

### Nurses Corner

ATHLETES: Sports physicals for incoming Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors were due July 1 to the Health Office. Incoming Freshman athletes are required to submit a completed State of Illinois Child Health Examination Form (version 11/2015) by July 1. PLEASE DO NOT TURN IN PHYSICALS TO A MEMBER OF ATHLETICS OR COACHES.

Class of 2018: The meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV4) is required for students to enter the 12th grade. In accordance with the State of Illinois, all 12th graders are required to have Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine. 2 dose of Meningococcal vaccine are required, with the first dose on or after the 10th birthday and the second dose at least 8 weeks after the 1st dose. Only one dose is required if the 1st dose was received at 16 years of age or older. Vaccine documentation is required to have a dated signature from the vaccine provider and may be faxed directly to the Health office at 815-741-3015 or mailed to the school with attention to Health Office. Submit your students proof of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV4) administration that is signed and dated by the provider BEFORE the start of school.

### **Incoming Freshmen Class of 2021:**

Reminder for parents that the Freshman physical form must be completed on the State of Illinois Child Health Examination Form (version 11/2015). In addition, page two has a required parent Health History section that is to be completed in its entirety including, allergies, medications, explanations of all questions answered "yes" and MUST be signed and dated by the parent. The completed Child Health Examination form fulfills the sports physical requirement; therefore, a sports physical is not needed. Fall athlete's physicals are due by August 3, non-athlete's physicals are requested by August 3 as well.

### **International Travelers:**

Students that travel more than 2 weeks to or are from high risk regions, as indicated by the CDC are required to have an annual Interferon-Gamma Release Assay (IGRA) completed in

the USA within 21 days prior to the start of each school year and upon returning from travel of 14 days or greater. Either the QuantiFERON® Gold In Tube test (QFT-GIT) or the T-SPOT® will be accepted. The current areas of high risk are: Latin America, the Caribbean, Africa, Asia, Eastern Europe, and Russia. Submit test results to the Health Office.

### Student Parking Tags

Student parking hangtags will be sold and student drivers will register on Thursday, August 10. Dear JCA Families,

Our school is partnered with The Cambridge Network to bring international students into our school from China, Korea, and Vietnam! This exciting initiative is part of our goal to provide our students with more enriching high school experiences through cross-cultural exchange in our classrooms. With this comes the exciting opportunity for you to potentially host a student for the upcoming year.

We are in need of families willing to open up their homes to an international student beginning in August 2016. Hosts should be able to provide a private bedroom, three meals a day and transportation arrangements to and from school for the 10-month academic school year.

To best support our host families, we are partnering with Cambridge's residential service provider, gphomestay, who will oversee our homestay program. Gphomestay provides a \$10,000 annual stipend to host families to offset the costs for bringing an international student into your home (\$1,000/month for 10 months) as well as ongoing support from a local Support Services Coordinator.

Host families do not have to have a student of their own enrolled at our school to be eligible to host. Please do share our need for host families with your personal networks. For any families that are referred and approved, the referring party will receive a \$300 referral bonus from Gphomestay. This could be a great opportunity for you to get involved even if you are not in a position to currently host!
