





Coach Scheibe

Christine Scheibe has been the varsity girls volleyball head coach for JCA since 2000 and was noted for reaching the 400-win mark quicker than any girls volleyball coach in HSA history. Under Scheibe, the Angels won the Class AA state title with a 39-21 record in 2003, followed by 3A state championships in 2008 and 2009. The Angels went 38-3 in 2008 and fashioned a program-best 41-1 record in 2009. ACA is one of the few schools in state volleyball history to play in three consecutive championship matches, finishing as the 3A runner-up in 2010. Her teams also placed third in 2006 and fourth in 2005. Scheibe (439-107-9) has coached JCA to 13 consecutive regional titles — the longest active streak among Will County high schools — along with seven sectional championships, six supersectional championships and six Final Four appearances. Scheibe, the vice president of the Illinois High School Volleyball Coaches Association, was named the Daily Southtown Coach of the Year in 2010, He Joliet Heral Avews Coach of the Year in 2011 and the East Suburban Catholic Conference Coach of the Year on multiple occasions.
