Phase II Capital Campaign "Building Our Future"

As JCA continues the second phase of our Capital Campaign "Building our Future" we would like to invite our parents to see exactly what we are planning. JCA will host four informational sessions for parents in order to better inform and engage you concerning the campaign.

Our vision is not complete. The second Phase of this Capital Initiative includes:

- Continuing installation of upgraded Wi-Fi to support our 1:1 Technology program.
- Windows for the back of the building.
- Air conditioning in all classrooms to provide our students with an optimal learning environment.
- Updates to the prayer garden for peaceful outdoor reflection.
- New lighting along Victory Road and Tradition Way.

These goals were set from the ideas of our focus groups consisting of parents, alumni, students and friends of JCA. We are set on raising \$1.532 million dollars to complete this initiative, thus giving our students a better JCA.

- 2. SENIORS need proof, signed and dated by the provider, of the MCV4/meningitis vaccine.



At Joliet Catholic Academy we are using a computerized cash register program which will be linked to the student's ID card. Students can choose to pre-deposit money on their account and use their student id card similar to a bank debit card or they can continue to use cash at breakfast and lunch. We will not accept credit cards in the cafeteria, credit cards can only be used for online pre-payments. Students can make account deposits in the cafeteria using cash or checks. All checks must be made payable to "Quest Food Management". Students can also bring a check or cash to the cafeteria to be deposited.

As of September 6th students must have money on their account or cash!

MealTime Online – Meal Account Deposits, enables you to make prepay deposits and payments on balances for your student's school lunch account, conveniently, safely and securely.

You can also view your student's account activity, including onsite payments, online payments, current balance and a detailed history of meal and food item purchases.

- Deposits can be made with any Discover, VISA, or MasterCard credit or debit card.
- Credit card processing is completed through a secure authorization process. MealTime Online does not retain or store Credit Card information and will never share your information with a third party.
- Online payments are processed immediately and will be reflected in the student's cafeteria account automatically, according to the district's scheduled transfer process.
- All student data that is transmitted is encrypted and authenticated every time you use the website.
- You can associate multiple students, from multiple schools, with one parent profile.
- MealTime Online can also be used to make payments for other school fees See <u>School Fee Payments</u>.
- MealTime Online can be used to make deposits into a student's cafeteria account, or any additional accounts set up by the school district.

Dear JCA Families,

Our school is partnered with The Cambridge Network to bring international students into our school from China, Korea, and Vietnam! This exciting initiative is part of our goal to provide our students with more enriching high school experiences through cross-cultural exchange in our classrooms. With this comes the exciting opportunity for you to potentially host a student for the upcoming year.

We are in need of families willing to open up their homes to an international student beginning in August 2016. Hosts should be able to provide a private bedroom, three meals a day and transportation arrangements to and from school for the 10-month academic school year.

To best support our host families, we are partnering with Cambridge's residential service provider, gphomestay, who will oversee our homestay program. Gphomestay provides a \$10,000 annual stipend to host families to offset the costs for bringing an international student into your home (\$1,000/month for 10 months) as well as ongoing support from a local Support Services Coordinator.

Host families do not have to have a student of their own enrolled at our school to be eligible to host. Please do share our need for host families with your personal networks. For any families that are referred and approved, the referring party will receive a \$300 referral bonus from Gphomestay. This could be a great opportunity for you to get involved even if you are not in a position to currently host!

We are very excited to start this new initiative. If you are interested in experiencing a new culture from the comforts of your own home while supporting our school, please contact our host recruitment coordinator, Dawn Habada at dhabada@thecambridgeinstitute.org or 617-749-7924.
