The first semester has flown by quickly, with only three weeks left until Christmas Break. This fall was highlighted by the dedication of our beautiful new Heritage Quad; complete with donor walls honoring our school's history, statues representing our two founding orders (our Lady of Mt. Carmel and St. Francis of Assisi), and the return of the Victory Light to campus.

Speaking of the Victory Light, it shined brightly several times this fall due to our students and alumni. In mid-October, over 350 alumni returned to campus for the annual Hilltopper and Angels Alumni Banquet. The Victory Light was lit up Cubbie blue in honor of the guest speaker, Chicago Cubs announcer Len Kasper, as the crowd was regaled with stories on the Cubs' historic World Series run. A great time was had by all. A huge thank you goes out to JCA Director of Alumni Relations Mrs. Sue Bebar, the Alumni Association (headed by President Jeff Phelan), and the entire JCA community of alumni and parent volunteers who pitched in to once again show the strength of the tradition at our great school.

Not long after the Cubs made history, two JCA seniors, Maddie Bauer and McCoy Hutchison, made a little history of their own, as the doubles partners helped JCA tennis capture its first State Championship Tennis trophy in late October. The strong performances by the "M&M" girls, who finished off a perfect 33-0 season with the Class 1A Championship, helped lead the Angels team to a state runner-up finish in Class 1A. A strong showing by freshman Mia Bertino, who finished tied for eighth in singles, solidified a historic year for the Angels.

The great thing about our Victory Light, and our strong tradition, is that it permeates throughout our school and community in all different areas. Besides celebrating our alumni and athletic performances, it also shines brightly during monumental victories for our students participating in other extra-curricular activities. The historical "firsts" this fall were recently capped off by JCA Drama productions (under the guidance of Drama Director Ms. Jenn Szynal) qualifying for the prestigious Illinois Theatre Fest with their fall production of "The Importance of Being Earnest". Illinois Theatre Fest is the largest and oldest non-competitive high school theatre festival in the world, and only a select number of high schools are chosen to perform at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign from January 5th-7th.

It truly is a great time to be part of the Hilltopper and Angel family. I wish you all a happy and blessed upcoming Christmas season.

Nurses Corner

Cold and flu season is upon us. IT IS NOT TOO LATE TO HAVE YOUR STUDENT VACCINATED FOR THE FLU.

Traveling and International Students: Students that travel more than 2 weeks to or are from high risk regions, as indicated by the CDC, are required to have an Interferon-Gamma Release Assay (IGRA) before returning to school and every year before the start of the new school year. Either the QuantiFER-ON®-Gold In-Tube test (QFT-GIT) or the T-SPOT® that have been completed in the United States will be accepted. The current areas of high risk are: Latin America, the Caribbean, Africa, Asia, Eastern Europe, and Russia.

ALL STUDENTS

All medications, including prescription, over the counter, or homeopathic, are to be kept in the Health Office with a Medication Authorization form. Medications are to be dispensed through the Health Office, EXCEPT those emergent medications, such as rescue inhalers, insulins, hypoglycemic agents and epinephrine injections. Emergent medication that the student will carry will also require Medication Authorization forms to be on file. The Medication Authorization form can be found online.


