Dear Parent /Guardian,

Thank you to our parents who volunteered and also to those that helped spread the word as ambassadors in admissions for our annual Open House on Sunday, October 29th. We will host our final Open House this Thursday night, November 9th from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. "Competitive Advantage Night" will have a different format, allowing prospective families to pick and choose presentations they wish to see, instead of the guided tour from our Sunday Open House.

One of our main presentations at both Open Houses this year relates to Tuition Assistance. We want to make sure our current and prospective families remain informed as it pertains to both merit-based scholarship (Franciscan/Carmelite Scholarships and the JCA Heritage Award) and need-based scholarship through the JCA Leveraged Financial Aid Program. There are also scholarships available through the Joliet Diocese's Catholic Education Foundation (CEF) and new this year for current and prospective families: Illinois Tax Credit Scholarships.

All current JCA families whose income level falls in line with the set forth guidelines from the Illinois Department of Revenue for Tax Credit Scholarships will be notified by JCA about the application process. A website and application will be available by January 1, 2018 for all current and prospective families. Current and incoming families can receive \$6,140 – \$12,280 in a tuition scholarship (paid directly to Joliet Catholic Academy). This year's Placement Exam will take place on Saturday, December 2, 2017 at 8 a.m. This is earlier than in years past, as the Chicago Archdiocesan and Joliet Diocesan High Schools are all moving their test forward. We would like you to encourage prospective students to sit for the placement exam, as merit based scholarships are tied to it for first-time test takers only. Also, Illinois Tax Credit Scholarships work on a first-come, first-serve basis, so families applying must have been accepted into a private school in order to fill out an application. For this reason, taking the initial Placement Exam early is more important than ever. We will also still offer a makeup Placement Exam on Saturday, December 9th, and then test by appointment only throughout the rest of the year. Please contact the Admissions Office if you know of any prospective families that may have questions about Tuition Assistance, the Placement Exam, or any admissions related questions.

Christian Service Hours

As we approach Thanksgiving, it is a great time to be thinking about Christian Service Hours. All JCA students are required to fulfill hours of service in the community. There are many ideas posted in Plus Portals in the form of specific events as well as links to organizations that would be grateful for volunteer efforts.

How many hours does my student need?

Freshmen – 5 hours; Sophomores – 10 hours; Juniors – 15 hours; and Seniors – 30 hours

People in need hours MUST make up at least half of the required hours regardless of how many Institution hours are submitted.

How are my student's hours recorded?

Volunteers should take a Service Hours form with them (attached on page 18 of the Parent Pride Newsletter) to collect the signature of a supervisor. These forms are available in the Counseling Department, on the bulletin board near Campus Ministry and can also be downloaded from the JCA website under the Faith tab. Completed forms are turned into Mrs. Scordo, in the Counseling Department, and then recorded in Plus Portals.

Nurses Corner

Flu season is just around the corner. Call your provider to schedule your flu shot or you can visit most local pharmacies to get your flu shot now. Please remember: Influenza is a highly contagious respiratory illness that can give you symptoms of a high fever, headache, sore throat, stuffy nose and achy muscles. A few tips to avoid getting the flu: Get your flu shot. Good handwashing, cover your mouth when you cough/sneeze and don't share drinks.

Sportsbrain, the concussion program for JCA, is active. If you suspect you have a concussion or if you have had a head injury, please register on sportsbrain and do the DAILY checklist for concussion symptoms. All students should have a baseline in Sportsbrain. If you have not had a baseline test yet, please contact Saul Ramirez, Athletic Trainer. ATHLETES: Sports physicals for incoming Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors were due July 1 to the Health Office. Sports physicals are good for 1 year from the date of the exam. If you will be trying out for a winter/spring sports, you will need your physical before tryouts and turn the physical in to the HEALTH OFFICE. PLEASE DO NOT TURN IN PHYSICALS TO A MEMBER OF ATHLETICS OR COACHES.

International Travelers: Students that travel more than 2 weeks to or are from high risk regions, as indicated by the CDC are required to have an annual Interferon-Gamma Release Assay (IGRA) completed.

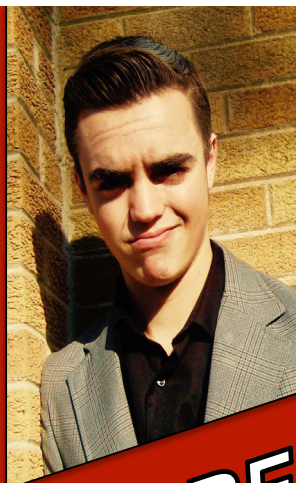
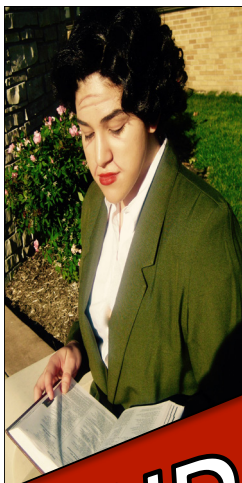

Examples of transfusion needs are:

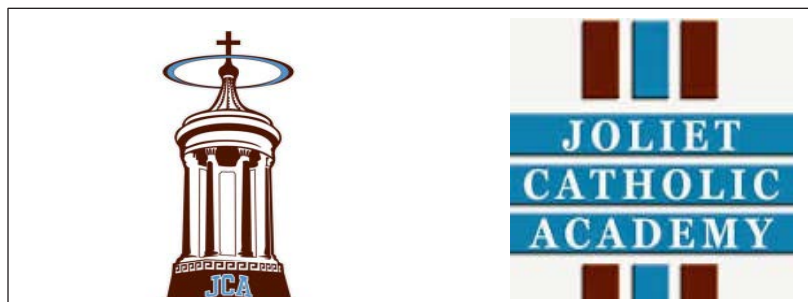
- Cancer: up to 8 units/month

- Liver Transplant: up to 100 units
- Auto Accident: up to 50 units
- Cardiovascular Surgery: 2-25 units

Students can choose to pre-deposit money on their account and use their student id card similar to a bank debit card or they can continue to use cash at breakfast and lunch. We will not accept credit cards in the cafeteria, credit cards can only be used for online pre-payments. Students can make account deposits in the cafeteria using cash or checks. MealTime Online – Meal Account Deposits, enables you to make prepay deposits and payments on balances for your student's school lunch account, conveniently, safely and securely.

You can also view your student's account activity, including onsite payments, online payments, current balance and a detailed history of meal and food item purchases.

- Deposits can be made with any Discover, VISA, or MasterCard credit or debit card.
- Credit card processing is completed through a secure authorization process. MealTime Online does not retain or store Credit Card information and will never share your information with a third party.
- Online payments are processed immediately and will be reflected in the student's cafeteria account automatically, according to the district's scheduled transfer process.
- All student data that is transmitted is encrypted and authenticated every time you use the website.
- You can associate multiple students, from multiple schools, with one parent profile.
- MealTime Online can also be used to make payments for other school fees See [School Fee Payments](#).
- MealTime Online can be used to make deposits into a student's cafeteria account, or any additional accounts set up by the school district.

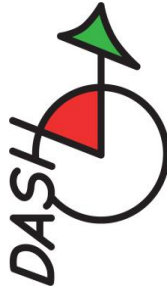

Dear JCA Families,

Our school is partnered with The Cambridge Network to bring international students into our school from China, Korea, and Vietnam! This exciting initiative is part of our goal to provide our students with more enriching high school experiences through cross-cultural exchange in our classrooms. With this comes the exciting opportunity for you to potentially host a student for the upcoming year.

We are in need of families willing to open up their homes to an international student beginning in August 2016. Hosts should be able to provide a private bedroom, three meals a day and transportation arrangements to and from school for the 10-month academic school year.

To best support our host families, we are partnering with Cambridge's residential service provider, gphomestay, who will oversee our homestay program. Gphomestay provides a \$10,000 annual stipend to host families to offset the costs for bringing an international student into your home (\$1,000/month for 10 months) as well as ongoing support from a local Support Services Coordinator.

Host families do not have to have a student of their own enrolled at our school to be eligible to host. Please do share our need for host families with your personal networks. For any families that are referred and approved, the referring party will receive a \$300 referral bonus from Gphomestay. This could be a great opportunity for you to get involved even if you are not in a position to currently host!
