## LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT/PRINCIPAL



Dear Alumni, Families and Friends,

This 2017-2018 school year has brought much excitement thus far to the JCA community. Aside from our tremendous Illinois State Scholar numbers (31), our record breaking numbers that will be attending the March for Life (71), and our Freshman Class Testing Numbers (204), we have had a remarkable year in the JCA community. The landscape of the Joliet Catholic Academy campus is changing, thanks to your vision, donations, and all-around help. Currently, we are finishing Phase II of our Capital Initiative which changed the look of the building with new energy efficient windows, strong Wi-Fi to aid with our 1:1 Technology Initiative, and our classroom air conditioning. This project coincides with our Strategic Plan 2013-2018 which will be ending in June of this year. Thus far we have raised a little over \$1.3 million

for a \$1.5 million-dollar goal. Hopefully, as we close the book on our 5-year plan, with your help, we can rest assured that we will achieve our monetary goal by school year's end.

# ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT

## Went to Harvard, worked at Citgo, played championship football at Joliet Catholic

JOLIET – The new U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of Illinois not only is from Joliet, but he's also in town a lot.

John R. Lausch Jr., who was sworn into office at a private ceremony Nov. 22 in Chicago, has not lost touch with his roots in Joliet, where he grew up in the Cathedral area and was a linebacker on the 1987 championship football team at what was then Joliet Catholic High School.

"I think he's very proud to be a Hilltopper," said Jeff Budz, principal at Joliet Catholic Academy, where Lausch regularly comes to career days to visit with students.

"There are probably seven or eight of us who have stayed friends," said former teammate Mike Kelley of Joliet. "We get together a lot. We talk a lot. I go to his kids' games."

"He even said the other day," said his mother, Barb Lausch, "On Thanksgiving, when we were sitting around talking, 'There's no friends like the old friends.'"

He's the son of Barb, who taught at the old St. Joseph's Catholic School, and Jack Lausch, a retired Joliet firefighter who made extra money as a repairman for Sears. They raised five children.

**"Even in high school, he outworked everybody," Kelley said. "That's how he became successful."**

Lausch was not available for an interview for this story. A spokesman for the U.S. attorney's office said he was not giving any media interviews for a few weeks.

Barb Lausch said her son told her not to talk to any media until after he was sworn into office,



despite being named weeks ago.

"He said, 'Until my hand's on the Bible, and I'm officially sworn in, nothing is set in stone,'" Barb said.

Becoming U.S. attorney is a serious matter. Some of Lausch's longtime associates from Joliet were visited by FBI agents in the background check that preceded his taking office.

Sue Bebar, director of alumni relations for JCA, recounted an amusing moment while being interviewed by an FBI agent who asked if Lausch's friends were people of good standing. Seeing a chance to interject some humor, Bebar said, "Well, I don't know about that."

The agent's face remained expressionless.

"He said, 'That's not funny,'" Bebar said.

Bebar and others describe Lausch, who now lives in Chicago, as a regular guy, hardworking, intelligent, moral and driven.

"He's all the things you expect for the position," Kelley said. "For people who know John, this is really not a surprise."

Lausch was an assistant U.S. attorney in the Chicago office from 1999 to 2010, trying more than 20 jury cases involving racketeering, fraud, narcotics, extortion and firearms offenses, according to the U.S. attorney's office. He was deputy chief in the narcotics and gangs section from 2005 to 2010, overseeing prosecutions involving street gangs, fraud schemes and corrupt public officials.

Barb and Jack sometimes went to see their son try cases, and once a lawyer from the opposing side approached them to make a comment about John.

"He said, 'We don't like to be in court with him because we never win,'" Barb said. "We said we're seeing a different person because he's really a soft, kind person. He was doing his job."

Lausch often was doing a job while going to high school and later at Harvard University, where he was captain of the football team. He had a janitorial job at the Cathedral of St. Raymond, where he went to grade school, and later worked at the Thomas Steel plant in Lemont during summer breaks. At Harvard, he worked for the athletic department.

One job that didn't work out, Barb said, was a short-lived stint as a vacuum cleaner salesman.

"He came home after the second day and said, 'I will do anything, but I won't do this,'" Barb said. "It was about two days later that he got the phone call from the refinery. So it worked out."

Kelley, who was a classmate at Joliet Catholic High School, where they both played football and baseball, said one of Lausch's strongest characteristics is his willingness to work.

"Even in high school, he outworked everybody," Kelley said. "That's how he became successful."

Lausch left the U.S. attorney's office to go into private practice in Chicago.

Barb said he wanted to broaden his experience as a lawyer but always wanted someday to go back to the U.S. attorney's office. He wanted to be U.S. attorney.

A public swearing-in ceremony is planned for January. The private ceremony on the day before Thanksgiving came so suddenly that his mother doesn't know whether Lausch knew when it was coming.

"All he wanted to do was go to work," she said. "I guess, as soon as he was sworn in, he went to work."

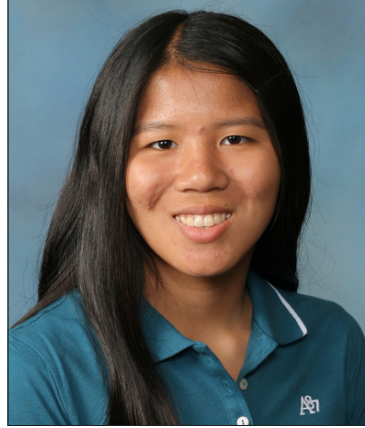

## JCA junior Jack Smith achieves perfect ACT score

Joliet Catholic Academy President/Principal Dr. Jeffrey Budz is proud to announce that junior Jack Smith, son of Jim and Kathy Smith, earned the highest possible ACT composite score of 36. On average, only around one-tenth of 1 percent of students who take the ACT earn a top score. In the U.S. high school graduating class of 2017, only 2,760 out of more than 2 million graduates who took the ACT earned a composite score of 36.

The ACT consists of tests in English, mathematics, reading and science, each scored on a scale of 1-36. A student's composite score is the average of the four test scores. The score for the ACT's optional writing test is reported separately and is not included within the ACT composite score.

ACT Chief Executive Officer Marten Roorda stated, "[Jack's] achievement on the ACT is significant and rare. While test scores are just one of multiple criteria that most colleges consider when making admissions decisions, [his] exceptional ACT composite score should prove helpful as [Jack] pursues his education and career goals."

The ACT is a curriculum-based achievement exam that measures what students have learned in school. Students who earn a 36 composite score have likely mastered all of the skills and knowledge they will need to succeed in first-year college courses in the core subject areas.

ACT scores are accepted by all major four-year colleges and universities across the U.S.

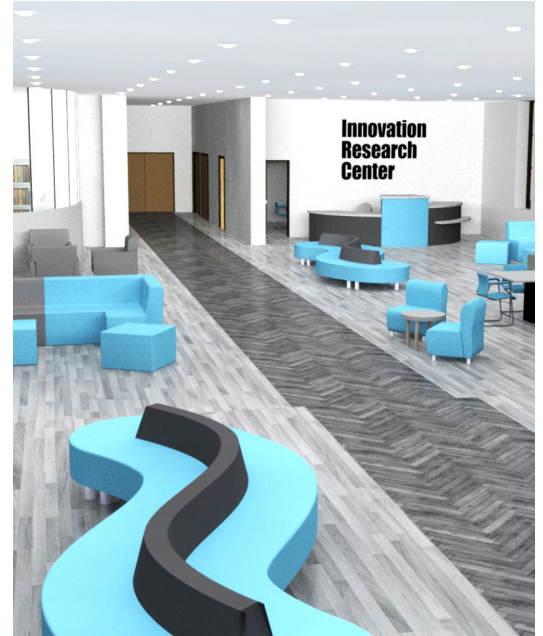

"#Onward JCA" has been visible throughout Joliet Catholic Academy's social media accounts over the last two years, but it isn't just a slogan borrowed from the "JCA March Onward to Vic-to-ry!" finale of the school's official fight song. It's an ever-present mantra highlighting JCA's forward momentum as a school spiritually, academically, and even physically here on campus at 1200 N. Larkin Ave. JCA students and staff continue to accomplish amazing things in the Joliet community by serving others; students are shaped academically by an administration and teaching staff invested in espousing the charisms of the Carmelites and Franciscans; and the physical building is ever changing with the recent completion of the Phase II Capital Initiative "Building Our Future". As JCA nears the completion of its 2013-2018 Strategic Plan, here are a few highlights of recently completed projects and a sneak-peak at what is to come.



**INNOVATION RESEARCH CENTER (Coming Soon)** – The new Innovation Research Center at Joliet Catholic Academy will provide a unique learning space for all of our students. The Innovation Research Center, or better known as the IRC, will be a cutting-edge media center that promotes learning through research, collaboration, and innovation. This space is designed for functionality and the use of leading technology. The IRC will be home to several modern collaboration work rooms, informal seating areas, and individual work spaces. Connecting just down the hall will be our Technology Center and STEM area equipped with rooms that include a dynamic computer lab, flexible labs, and a Robotics and Engineering lab. The modernizing of these spaces will allow JCA to continue to live its mission of cultivating opportunities for academic excellence for all our students.







**DANCE ROOM (Completed)** – JCA's Dance Team, fresh off a 1st place finish in the IHSA regional at Waubonsie Valley H.S. in their inaugural year competing at the IHSA level, recently received an updated practice space. The new Dance Room, located in the former Room 6 on the lower level of the school behind the cafeteria, provides a place for both the Dance Team and JCA's Drama Department to rehearse routines and prepare for performances. The space contains brand new glass mirrors located along the south wall, as well as a state-of-the-art dance floor. A special thanks goes out to Al Palucci for his time and treasure in making this dream a reality.



**WEIGHT ROOM (Completed)** – The JCA weight room recently received a much-needed face lift with the addition of rubber mats along the perimeter and a 20 x 90 artificial turf installation, providing an area to perform more functional movements for Angels and Hilltoppers during athletic contest preparation and in physical education classes. The flooring, new paint, and new barbells were all made possible due to the generous donation of Mr. Al Graham '66. The space was also updated with new squat racks and Olympic lifting platforms, donated by former Hilltopper great and NFL star Mike Alstott '92. Both Graham and Alstott have continually aided in the progress of updating the weight room over the years.



**CHAPEL (Coming Soon)** – Thanks to a generous contribution from LaVerne and Dorothy Brown, the Chapel will be moved to the front of the building located along Larkin Ave. on the second floor, directly above the main entrance to the school. The small "Adoration Chapel" will still remain, with the new Chapel to include updated wood flooring, stone walls, and wood chairs to seat over 270, creating an earthy natural feeling. Natural light will be infused thanks to the brand new large windows located on the front face of the west side of the building, with hanging stained glass artworks of St. Francis and Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. The San Damiano Cross, the large Romanesque rood cross before which St. Francis of Assisi was praying when he is said to have received the commission from the Lord to rebuild the church, will hang above the altar.



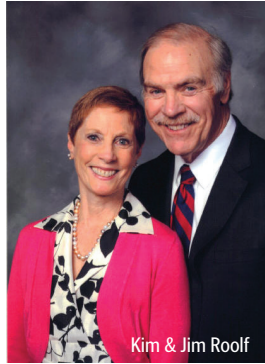


# Jubilaté 2018

## “Gannon, Grant rock at Hilltopper Banquet”

Sue Gulas called it her dream pairing.

Terry Gannon and Mark Grant demonstrated why she felt that way.

Gulas and Sue Bebar, the Joliet Catholic Academy director of alumni relations, were primarily responsible for bringing together the pairing of 1981 Joliet Catholic graduates for last Thursday night's Hilltopper Banquet at the JCA Student Activity Center.

Gannon, the featured guest, is a jack-of-all-trades when it comes to sports television broadcasting. Grant, who annually serves as master of ceremonies and conducts a back-and-forth exchange with the featured guest at the Hilltopper Banquet, is the color commentator for

San Diego Padres telecasts.

In some ways, they are night and day. Put them together, and you have a free-and-easy exchange in a night loaded with laughs, many involving their coaches and teachers while they were in high school.

Grant, of course, always has material, and he certainly does not mind using it even when it means ripping into himself, over things that happened in high school and beyond.

Gannon attended North Carolina State, where he played basketball for Jim Valvano and was a contributor on the Wolfpack's 1983 national championship team.

He came armed with material about his late father and true character Jim Gannon, a former Joliet Catholic basketball coach, plus Valvano and much more.

Before the program began, Jeff Phelan, president of the JCA Alumni Association, said he thought this banquet was as good as or better than any such banquet in the area, and that's because this one has Grant as the master of ceremonies.

Then Ryan Quigley, the JCA director of admissions and communications, informed the audience of all the academic achievements and building improvements that are ongoing at JCA. Grant wasn't about to let that go.

“Ryan, don't you have an update on the bathrooms? I heard there's new porcelain,” he joked. “Sue [Gulas] said this was her dream banquet. Any time you get Ryan Quigley and Jeff Phelan to go on and on like that, it's a dream banquet.”

The night was off and running.



## HILLTOPPER GARB

Gannon and Grant shed their suit jackets and donned some old Joliet Catholic garb – Gannon a hoodie, Grant a beanie that Gannon told him he had to wear along with a jacket.

“They don’t make these things as big as they used to,” Grant said as Gannon tried to help him get the jacket snapped.



“How about this one,” Gannon said as he pulled out a tiny Joliet Catholic shirt that he received from his mom, Mary Fran, when he was a year old. “It was 1964, when a Joliet Catholic team my dad coached was Suburban Catholic Conference champion.

“It all started with my mom and dad.”

Ah, yes, Gannon’s dad.

“Let’s see a show of hands,” Terry said. “How many of you had my dad for history? How many learned any history? How many of you got sent to the corner store to buy a carton of cigarettes? How many got sent there to buy a racing form?”

That brought laughs, especially from those who knew Jim Gannon.

Terry Gannon was not all basketball. He also was an excellent baseball player.

“I remember stopping at your house on the way to practice one day,” Grant said, “And there’s this phone on the wall with a weird wire running out of it down to something on the floor, a recorder or whatever it was.”

“When people make bets, you gotta remember ‘em,” Gannon responded. “He may have made a wager or two. He may have taken a bet or two. He lost a bet one time when Dick Van Dyke was on. After that, we knew not to click on Dick Van Dyke, or he would kill us. He was superstitious.”

## ROAD TO VEGAS

Then there was the time Terry was 15, not yet

in possession of a driver’s license.

“I get home and my dad tells me to get the car, we’re going get Uncle Kenny and we’re going to Las Vegas,” he said. “I asked why. He said because Uncle Kenny has to get out of town.

“So it’s 2 in the morning. We’re out in the middle of the Nebraska cornfields and the gas gauge is on ‘E’. We pass a station and the sign says it’s 30-some miles to the next one. Dad says to Uncle Kenny, I’ll bet you a hundred we can make it. We did, and we went on to Vegas.”

During Valvano’s visit to the Gannon home to recruit Terry, he made himself right at home.

“My dad was sitting at the dining room table, and [Valvano] walks in there and sits down with him,” Gannon said. “My mom and I are alone in the living room, and those two spend 45 minutes together – with him telling dad everyone to bet on that night.”

And, when Valvano left, his dad told him he was going to N.C. State.

That was a godsend for Gannon, who always had dreamed of playing at Notre Dame.

The Irish were recruiting Gannon but instead decided to give their last available scholarship to Dan Duff of Lincoln.

“We were at every Notre Dame football game from the time I was 5 until I went to N.C. State,” Gannon said. “When they took Duff, it was a crushing blow. I threw out all my Notre Dame stuff.

“Years later, I walked into the television studio

for a game I was working with Digger Phelps. I said, ‘You’re not wearing your ring today ... Oh, you don’t have a ring.’ He didn’t like that.”

## ACC & BEYOND

Gannon relayed stories about playing against the likes of Michael Jordan, Sam Perkins and Ralph Sampson in the ACC, and against Houston’s Hakeem Olajuwon and Clyde Drexler in the national championship game.

“Drexler had jumped over the top of a guy and I said I’m not going to let him do that to me, I’ll tackle him first. So I did,” Gannon said. “Years later, I saw him, went up to him and said, ‘Remember me? I’m Gannon.’ He remembered me and said, ‘You are still all those things I called you.’”

When his playing days were over, Gannon was a grad assistant for Valvano.

“V was the smartest, most energetic guy I’ve ever known,” he said. “I went to talk to him. I said I have an offer to play professionally in Europe, could stay on and help him at N.C. State and had an offer to do TV work. What should I do?

“He told me, ‘Go do the TV work and if you don’t like it, you’ll always have a job here coaching for me.’ I thought, this is my big life decision and he talks to me about it for 30 seconds. That’s it?”

The end result, though, has been a dream life for Gannon, who among other assignments will be in Seoul, South Korea, in February to serve as NBC’s play-by-play man for figure skating at the Winter Olympics

# LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT

*Dear alumni, families, and friends*

Illinois enacted the Invest In Kids Scholarship Tax Credit Program in 2017. This program offers a 75 percent income tax credit to individuals and businesses that contribute to qualified Scholarship Granting Organizations (SGOs). The SGOs then provide scholarships for students whose families meet the income requirements to attend qualified, non-public schools in Illinois.

Donors interested in receiving a tax credit should register as soon as possible with [mytax.illinois.gov](http://mytax.illinois.gov) in order to apply for the tax credit. Applications opened January 2, 2018.

## TAX CREDIT SCHOLARSHIPS

The Tax Credit Scholarship will cover up to 100% of private school tuition up to a maximum of the average Illinois cost to educate which is roughly \$13,000. Students with unique learning needs, including those who are gifted, English language learners, or those with special education qualifications, will receive larger scholarships — up to double— roughly \$26,000. Key information about the program and donating to these scholarships can be found below.

## TAX CREDITS

Individual and corporate donors may receive a credit for their Illinois state taxes equal to 75 percent of donations to an SGO.

• **A taxpayer donates \$10,000 to an SGO; they are eligible to claim a \$7,500 tax credit on their 2018 taxes.**

Tax credits are capped at \$1 million per taxpayer per year; a donor can contribute about \$1.33 million to receive the maximum tax credit allowed. Donors cannot receive a federal deduction for gifts made through this program, but the net tax benefit to all donors is expected to be greater than ordinary charitable donations of an equal amount. Total tax credits are capped at \$75 million per year statewide, which equates to \$100 million in donations and scholarships. Please consult a tax professional to determine how such gifts will affect tax liability.

## EMPOWER ILLINOIS

Empower Illinois is an independent 501(c)(3) non-profit SGO responsible for serving approximately 80% of participating private schools statewide; including all of Illinois' Catholic Dioceses, most area Jewish schools, Lutheran Schools, secular schools and many more. Empower Illinois is responsible for:

- **Processing donations from individuals and corporations**
- **Accepting scholarship applications from students/families**
- **Distributing scholarships to eligible students/families in accordance with the law**
