	Short length must extend by at least 2 inches beyond the hem of the jersey- it cannot cover the entire short
Wednesday, Sept. 26 –Way Back Wednesday	Not acceptable
Trends from the decades including 90s Grunge, 80s preppy, neon, big hair, 70s Disc, 60s Hippy/ Flower Child, 50s poodle skirts and greasers	SEE ABOVE
yoga pants may be worn with a LONG sweater, sweatshirt, tunic that comes to finger length (see short guidelines in handbook)	Any attire referring to drugs, alcohol, tobacco or sex
Destressed jeans with small tears	Shorts so short the top covers the entire short
