Dear Incoming senior parent/guardian,

In accordance with requirements of Public Act 90-0607, upon entering the **TWELFTH** grade of any public, private, or parochial school, students are to *have received* an immunization containing MENINGOCOCCAL CONJUGATE VACCINE (MCV4). The immunization requirement consists of:

The first dose received on or after the 11th birthday; second dose on or after the 16th birthday. An interval of least eight weeks after the first dose. Only one dose is required if the first dose was received at 16 years of age or older. No proof of immunity allowed.

Documentation from the provider indicating that the MCV4 vaccine was administered, *including both the providers signature and date of administration*, is to be submitted to the Health Office *prior* to the start of the school year.

In accordance with the State of Illinois, students who are not in compliance with medical records are required to be excluded from school and all school activities, including sports, beginning on October 15 and until the records are in compliance with State of Illinois guidelines.
