We are writing to inform you of important information concerning the Covid-19 virus in our school community. It has come to our attention that the parents (both mom and dad) of one of our students have self-reported positive tests for COVID-19. The parents were having symptoms this past week, saw their family physician, and were tested accordingly. The Will County Health Department has given them a quarantine time of seven days, once they are symptom-free. These parents have not been on our campus in the month of March, well before our last day on March 13th. After speaking with dad, he states that they both are feeling a lot better, but please keep this family in your prayers.

Please know that the safety and health of our students and families is of the utmost importance to us. If you are experiencing any type of symptom, please consult your family doctor. Also, please inform us as soon as possible, so we can take any needed steps to protect the well-being of our students and families. We are always available via email.
