In Memory of Dorothy Mae “Dottie” Brown



Dorothy Mae “Dottie” Brown, passed away peacefully in her Joliet home, 96 years after she was born in her parents' home on Highland Avenue. She was a member of the Joliet Township High School Class of '41, a lifelong parishioner at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church, and one of the last of the Great Generation of Jolietans who made the city what it is today. Dottie and her

late husband were strong advocates for Joliet and Will County, renowned for their philanthropy and tireless dedication to local education, health care, and service to the needy.

Their company, Brown and Lambrecht Earthmovers became a major regional civil contractor, providing gainful employment to thousands of individuals throughout Illinois and the Midwest.

Dottie was preceded in death by her dear husband, LaVerne “Bitz” Brown. For the last 60 years, Dottie has been a driving force in a number of local non-profit service organizations. Joliet Area Community Hospice, Sisters of St. Francis of Mary Immaculate, The University of St. Francis, Lewis University, Joliet Catholic Academy, Providence High School, The Silver Cross Foundation, St. Joseph Hospital, Childerguild, and the Diocese of Joliet are just some of the entities that benefitted from generous gifts of both time and treasure by Dottie and Bitz Brown. Numerous buildings in the area memorialize the names and legacy of this legendary couple, including the Mary, Our Sister Chapel, which serves as the center point of the faith community on campus at JCA. The Brown's provided the lead gift for the newly created chapel at JCA, which was dedicated in the fall of 2018. The JCA community is forever grateful that Dottie could attend that special night and for their generosity towards Catholic education in Joliet

JCA Student Council partners with Diocese of Joliet Catholic Charities for annual Christmas Drive

Ericka Williams, Manager of Family and Child Support Services for Catholic Charities (Early Head Start and Head Start), spoke to JCA's Student Council Members about the impact they can have on these families. She is a 1986 graduate of St. Francis Academy (Joliet Catholic High School and St. Francis merged to form JCA in 1990). Erika is responsible for overseeing the social services component areas on a daily basis which includes managing the center's transportation, child care, father engagement, and family engagement. She feels that it is the responsibility of all Early Childhood Educators to nurture, motivate and educate parents in understanding the impact of their positive parenting in their children's lives.

Many times families in the Joliet community may not be homeless, but are "houseless", jumping from one residence to another without a permanent residence. Some families do not have access to clean water within their homes, so Catholic Charities provides water. The Christmas season is a great time to reflect on Jesus' message in Acts 20:35, "it is more blessed to give than to receive."

Joliet Catholic Academy president/principal Dr. Jeffrey Budz is proud to announce that JCA senior Makenzie Kaput has been named a Commended Student in the 2020 National Merit Scholarship Program. A Letter of Commendation from the school and the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC), which conducts the program, will be presented by the principal to this scholastically talented senior.

About 34,000 Commended Students throughout the nation are being recognized for their exceptional academic promise. Although they will not continue in the 2020 competition for National Merit Scholarship awards, Commended Students placed among the top 50,000 scorers of more than 1.5 million students who entered the 2020 competition by taking the 2018 Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT).

Students have demonstrated outstanding potential for academic success,” commented a spokesperson for NMSC. “These students represent a valuable national resource; recognizing their accomplishments, as well as the key role their schools play in their academic development, is vital to the advancement of educational excellence in our nation. Fr. John Honiotes, parochial vicar at St. Raphael's in Naperville and a Diocese of Joliet Catholic priest, returned back to campus in October to celebrate JCA's annual Heritage Week All-School Mass. Fr. John graduated from JCA in 2005. JCA faculty, students, and friends honored the contributions of our co-sponsors the Carmelites and the Joliet Franciscan Sisters. Freshman students, transfer students, and new faculty members were also invested with the Carmelite scapular and received a San Damiano Cross.

In the year 1251, in the town of Aylesford in England, Our Lady appeared to St. Simon Stock, a Carmelite. She handed him a brown woolen scapular and said, "This shall be a privilege for you and all Carmelites, that anyone dying in this habit shall not suffer eternal fire." In time, the Church extended this magnificent privilege to all the laity who are willing to be invested in the Brown Scapular of the Carmelites and who perpetually wear it.

While still in his early 20's and seeking his place in the world, Francis of Assisi was praying before this cross when he heard the voice of God commanding him to "rebuild my church."

Fr. John spoke in his homily of turning to God's love in an increasingly dark and sad world. His message resonated with JCA students, staff, and parents in attendance. This presented a great opportunity for JCA students to see religious vocations at work firsthand within the Diocese of Joliet.





JCA celebrates 35 years



Joliet Catholic Academy 2020 Recognition Award Recipients: Tom Carbery ('49) and Family

Last year Tom Carbery celebrated his 70th anniversary as a graduate of the 1949 class of Joliet Catholic High School. Tom represents a generation of alumni who sustained Joliet Catholic Academy and its predecessor schools, Joliet Catholic High School and Saint Francis Academy for decades through their service, commitment and love for the extended JCA community. He maintains and treasures dear friendships with many alumni of that era including Pat Peyla, Bob and Rosemary Stephen and Jean Konrad among many others. He considers all Hilltoppers and Angels part of his extended family.

The highlight of Tom's high school career was his first date with his wife, Joan (Elwood) Carbery at the 1947 Junior Prom. Tom had been selected as King of the "Lilac Glow" but was inexplicably abandoned by his date, two nights before the prom. At the prompting of his mother, Tom's father (also Tom Carbery) contacted his childhood neighbor, Joan's mother, Agnes Elwood and arranged an emergency date that proved fateful. Though romantically inept, Tom served as Class President and standout football and basketball athlete. He remains the only Carbery football player whose picture was featured in the

Chicago Tribune.

Professionally Tom was a civil engineer at Chicago Bridge and Iron Company (forerunner to CBI Industries) for most of his career. A highlight of his professional life was his 1969 stint in Dubai where he was part of a team that deployed the world's first off shore oil storage facility in the Middle East. The project was nominated for honors by the National Society of Engineers whose only two other nominees were the Boeing 747 and the NASA space program. Tom inspired a generation of students to explore the world upon his return through presentations to local schools.

Like so many alumni of JCA from his era, Tom has found countless opportunities to serve his alma mater and his community. He and Joan were Chairpersons of Jubilation in 1982 together with Marilyn and the late James Tyler. He continues his community service in his 89th year as a volunteer at Silver Cross Hospital each Saturday morning. He makes frequent appearances at many JCA events where he rocks a class of '49 letter sweater.

Tom is a lifelong resident of Lockport and Fairmont and a devoted member of St Dennis Parish. Tom and Joan have four children who are also JCA alumni – Mike (JCHS 1976), Steve (JCHS 1978), Paul (JCHS 1979) and Patti (SFA 1982). Their JCA educations have propelled them to careers in education, architecture and finance and a lifelong passion for world travel which Tom fostered. Tom is grandfather to seven grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

FALL ATHLETIC ROUNDUP



Joliet Catholic Academy students are excelling in extra-curriculars, athletics, the performing arts and community service. The 2019-2020 school year is off to an incredible start with successes carrying over from the classroom to the playing field and the stage. Here are some highlights from the fall of 2019 so far:



- **JCA girls tennis** senior Mia Bertino capped off an incredible high school career recently, cementing her status as one of Joliet's greatest female tennis players in the last thirty years. Bertino captured fifth place in the IHSA Class 1A state tennis finals to cap off a 38-2 season. Her four-year overall record was 142-12. Bertino was a four-time state qualifier finishing seventh her first two seasons and fifth place the past two seasons.



- **The Hilltopper football** program followed up a 2018 IHSA State Championship title run by celebrating 100 years of Hilltopper football during the 2019 season and capturing the 2019 ESCC/CCL White Division Conference Championship. Head coach Jake Jaworski was named the Coach of the Year, sophomore running back Jordan Anderson was named White Division Most Outstanding Player, senior running back Kenyetta Williams, Sr. was named Most Valuable Offensive Player. Anderson and junior defensive back Jabril Williams were named IHSA Class 5A All-State Honorable Mention. The Hilltoppers finished 8-4 overall with a last second loss in the IHSA Class 5A state quarterfinals 21-14 to Mascoutah.

- **The JCA Angels girls volleyball** program captured their 10th state trophy in the past 17 years under Hall of Fame head coach Christine Scheibe this fall. The Angels finished as the IHSA Class 3A state runner-up with a 26-15 overall record. The girls battled



injuries throughout the season, but persevered in the end going 15-4 in their final 19 matches. Junior Kristen Leusler and senior captain Bella Ray were named to the ESCC All-Conference team. The ESCC is year-in-year out the top volleyball conference in the state of Illinois and this year featured sectional championship teams from JCA, Benet, Marist, and Nazareth.



- **The JCA boys soccer** program captured the first sectional championship in program history 1-0 over Herscher. The Hilltoppers have captured back-to-back regional championships under the direction of head coach Tom Cranmer and were led by senior all-conference honorees Tyler Kaput and Kyle Michael.

- The 2019 edition of the **JCA boys and girls cross-country** squads once again had a successful season under the direction of Jason Midlock, Mark Clark, and Rachel Reyes. Both programs advanced to the IHSA sectional in Lisle, with the boys finishing in 4th place at the IHSA regionals and the girls finishing 7th. JCA senior Marcus Porchia was the lone state qualifier from the program. Porchia set a personal record at the IHSA State Finals in Peoria at Detwiler Park on November 9, 2020. Porchia ran the course in 16:24:75, good for a 5:28 milesplit.

Please note, this is an early signing period. JCA will host several other signing days throughout the spring as students make their collegiate commitments.

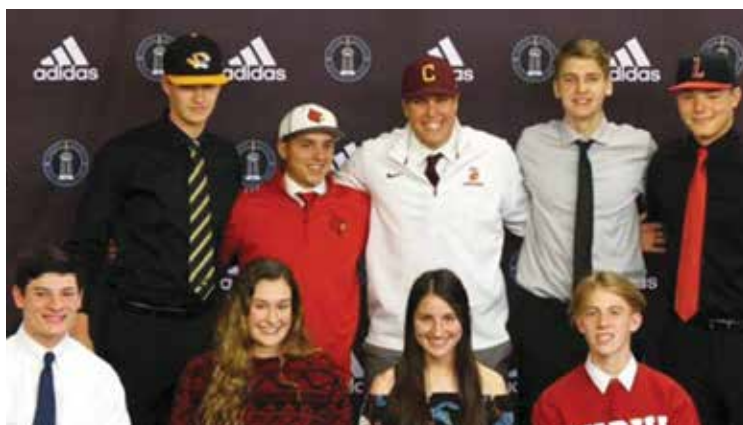

Highlighted Scholarships

During the 2019-2020 school year JCA provided over \$1.3 million in scholarships to 50% of the current study body. Scholarships ranged from \$500 to \$13,336.64 through the various programs that make up JCA's Leveraged Financial Aid program. Students were eligible to receive awards from the JCA Endowment, the Diocese of Joliet's Catholic Education Foundation, the JCA Heritage Award Scholarship Program, Franciscan and Carmelite Entrance Exam Top Scorer Scholarships, and Illinois' growing Tax-Credit Scholarship Program administered by scholarship granting organization Empower Illinois.

JCA student scholarships in the need-based financial aid program are made possible by over 30 endowed scholarships that have been setup in memory of JCA families and loved ones. JCA awards scholarships yearly based off the interest of these scholarship. Additional scholarship are awarded yearly from 25 non-endowed scholarship. These donors, families, and groups

make yearly gifts to JCA in order to continue-on the named non-endowed scholarship. Several classes celebrating milestone reunions also make non-endowed gifts for tuition assistance.

Gifts to Joliet Catholic Academy, whether current or deferred, large or small, help to ensure that the tradition of a JCA education can remain strong and that students are able to pursue a secondary school education. 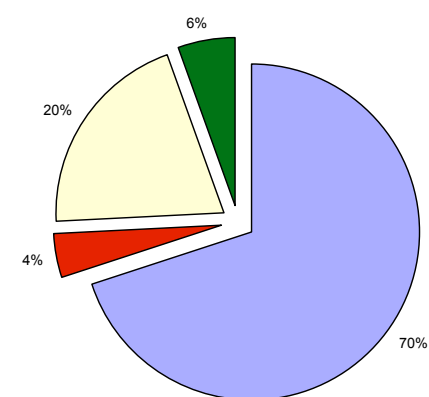

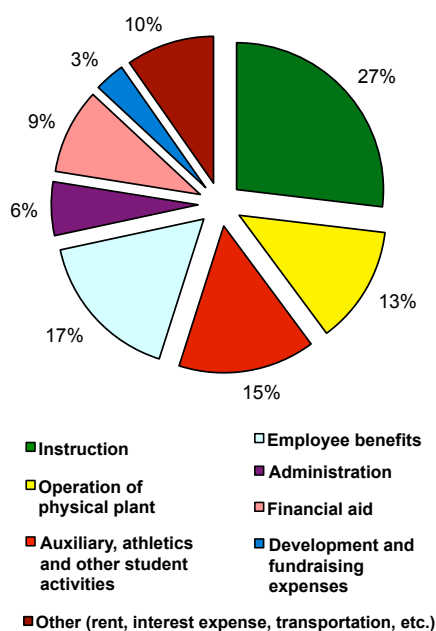

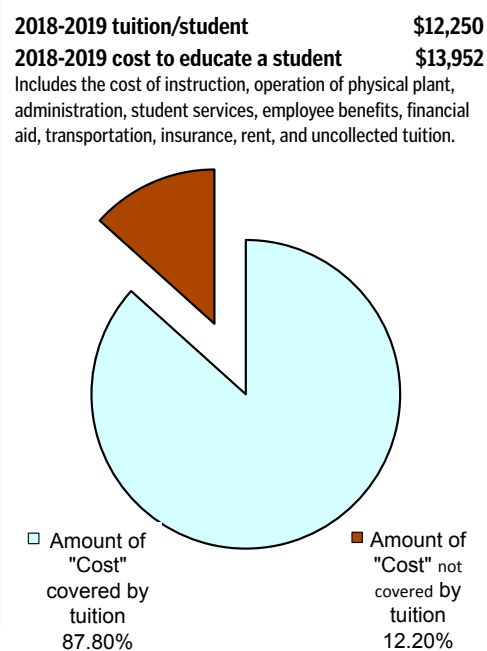
