LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT/PRINCIPAL



Dear Joliet Catholic Academy Community,

After careful consideration we have decided to return to in-person learning for our entire school community starting in the 4th quarter (Monday, March 15). We will have a four-day (all student-in person) school week with one remote half-day of learning. These four days will be full school days; 7:50 a.m. -2:40 p.m. As stated, we will still have one half-day of remote learning for all, which will be scheduled for Wednesdays (even though that scheduled day could change depending on other calendar factors).

We are still allowing a fully remote option for families that wish to keep their children at home. We will still follow IDPH and ISBE mitigations and restrictions and quarantine students when deemed appropriate.

I truly appreciate the cooperation and concern from our students, parents, and JCA community as we have addressed the COVID-19 pandemic this year and I thank you in advance for your continued support and diligence in helping to provide a safe environment for our students, faculty and staff. My continued prayers are for you and our students for a successful end of the school year and a healthier spring as we all move beyond COVID-19.

JCA seniors and their families are excited that we will be moving forward with end of the year events (Graduation, Prom, Senior Celebration), although they will all look a little different. Details on these events will be shared with the larger JCA community as we get closer to the event dates.

Please know, as always, what we have learned through this pandemic, is that plans can change at a moment's notice and we will adjust as a school community when necessary. I truly appreciate your patience and your dedication to our school and our community.

I would like to commend our teachers and staff at this point for their work and full-time effort teaching the full curriculum and using their time to make sure that our students are challenged each day as if there weren't demands placed upon them. The work of our faculty and staff is nothing short of remarkable!

With all that is happening in our world and in our school, we still maintain our vision for the future and the plans we have made together to make JCA an even better institution. We are in year three of our 5-year Strategic Plan (Onward Together 2018-2023) and over the last two years we have made great strides to improve our school. Out of the 28 strategies for improvement that our community of over 100 volunteers devised for the plan, we have already addressed 18 of those 28 strategies. If you would like to take a look at the full document, you can access it on our website under the "Our School" tab.

We are excited to report that the Warning Family Innovation Research Center is in the final phases of completion with only the AV instillation and the ordering of furniture on our list. I am sure that our community will be impressed. Looking ahead, next on the Strategic Plan in terms of Capital Campaigns, we are going to address the back fields and look to improve the outdoor facilities. You can see a little more detail of this under Goal D of the Strategic Plan.

I would like to end with wishing everyone peace and good health as we continue to battle COVID, anxiety, and any other hardships that our families might be enduring. You will always be the heart of our school, and I am grateful for all that you do to make our school special.

JCA to offer “Spring Showcases” for area 6th and 7th Grade Prospective Students

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic several events during the 2020-2021 calendar year have been postponed or cancelled, both at Joliet Catholic Academy and for our local Catholic and public grade schools. This past November, the JCA Admissions office, faculty, and staff adjusted typical Open House to include smaller crowd sizes and individual private tours. In-person admissions visits to local grade schools have also been put on hold, to prioritize the time for in-person instruction. Social distancing requirements in classrooms have also caused Diocese of Joliet Catholic High Schools to pause typical “Friday Shadow Visits” for area 6th, 7th, and 8th graders.

JCA is excited to announce our “Spring Showcases”, geared specifically for area 6th and 7th grade students. These free one-day clinics are scheduled throughout April and May, providing area students the opportunity to see and participate in JCA classes, sports, clubs, and more. Below is a snapshot of some of the offered showcases. Pre-registration is required to allow for social distancing and some camps may be limited to the number of total attendees based on demand. All IDPH and ISBE guidelines for in-person instruction and indoor and outdoor athletic activities will be followed.

JCA still plans on offering its full schedule of Summer Camps in June and July, which will be open to all grade levels.

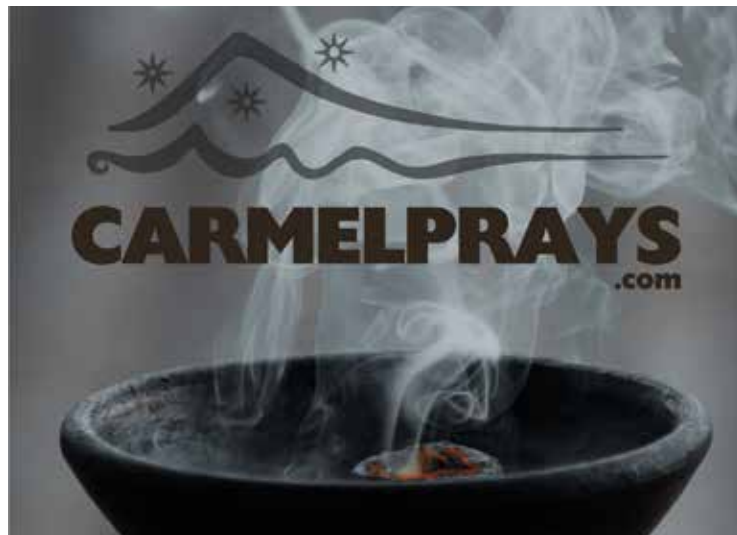

Pope Benedict XVI and Pope Francis, each on different occasions, reminded and challenged the Carmelites: “Carmel teaches the Church how to pray.” As a response to this challenge, the Carmelites of the Province of the Most Pure Heart of Mary (PCM), co-sponsors of Joliet Catholic Academy, established CarmelPrays.com – a daily interactive Carmelite prayer hub - beginning on the first day of Advent in 2020.

CarmelPrays is a work in progress; when fully completed, the hub will offer text, video, and audio of Morning, Evening, and Night Prayer in “the Sant’Angelo-Style,” allowing for the opportunity to pray together - virtually - as one community. CarmelPrays will also furnish the texts of the rosary to pray with a reader and additional meditation tools.



JCA senior Isabelle Egizio achieves Perfect ACT Score

Joliet Catholic Academy senior Isabelle Egizio, daughter of Stephen and Erica Egizio, earned the highest possible ACT composite score of 36.

JCA president/principal Dr. Jeffery Budz said, “On behalf of the JCA administration, faculty and staff, we offer our heartiest congratulations to Isabelle on her amazing accomplishment. We are so proud of her perfect 36 on the ACT and know that she has worked very hard to attain her goals. We know that Isabelle will find success in all that she sets her mind to in college and beyond.”

Fewer than half of 1 percent of students who take the ACT earn a top score. In the U.S. high school graduating class of 2020, only 5,579 out of 1.67 million students who took the ACT earned a top composite score of 36.

The ACT consists of tests in English, mathematics, reading and science, each scored on a scale of 1–36. A student’s composite score is the average of the four test scores. The score for ACT’s optional writing test is reported separately and is not included within the ACT composite score.

“Earning a top score on the ACT is a remarkable achievement,”

said ACT CEO Janet Godwin. “A student’s exceptional score of 36 will provide any college or university with ample evidence of their readiness for the academic rigors that lie ahead.”

The ACT is a curriculum-based achievement exam that measures what students have learned in school. Students who earn a 36 composite score have likely mastered all of the skills and knowledge they will need to succeed in first-year college courses in the core subject areas.

ACT scores are accepted by all major four-year colleges and universities across the US.

Egizio, of Plainfield, IL, was also named a semifinalist in the 2021 National Merit Scholarship Program back in September. On the perfect ACT score Egizio said, “it was unexpected, as I was hoping for something above a 30. It was a lot of hard work in and out of school and with ACT prep. I’m very excited about the academic opportunities and potential college opportunities.”

Despite the challenges of remote learning in the spring of 2020 and hybrid learning both on-campus and off-campus this fall due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Egizio and her fellow JCA classmates have risen to the challenge. She said, “my favorite memory this past year is actually COVID, and how our classmates have come together. The constant support from teachers and classmates is something I will always remember and be grateful for.”

Egizio plans to major in chemical engineering and hopes to attend the University of Southern California. She has a career goal to work in either the food management industry or in a sustainable energy field.



JCA Celebrates Ash Wednesday in Unique Fashion

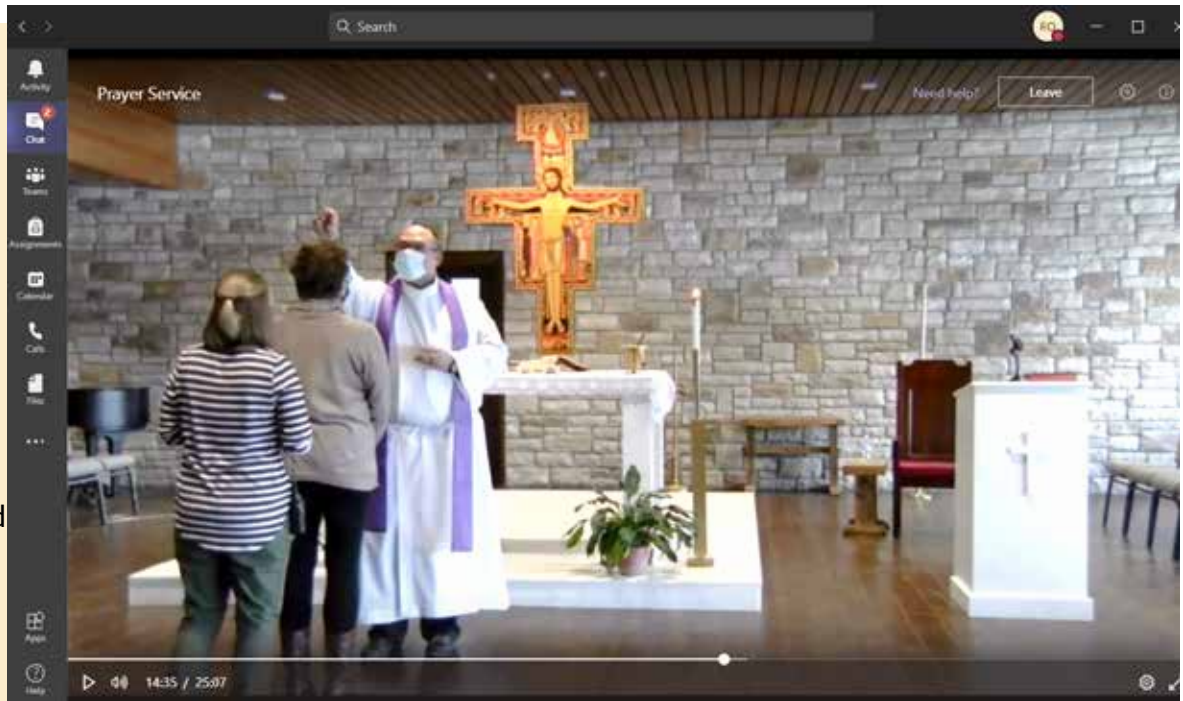
Joliet Catholic Academy staff and students, both in-person and virtually, participated in today's Ash Wednesday Mass. Mass was streamed live from the Mary, Our Sister Chapel to students physically present in their 8th period classes and at home.

JCA extraordinary ministers (adult faculty and staff) then visited 8th period classes to distribute ashes in the European fashion, sprinkled on the top of the head.

Thank you to Fr. Jeff Smialek, O.Carm. and Mrs. Missy Ferro in campus ministry for coordinating this special day, a solemn reminder of human mortality and the need for reconciliation with God. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, a 40-day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving in preparation for the celebration of our Lord's Resurrection at Easter.

During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ.

Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but we are also called to practice self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season. Contemplate the meaning and origins of the Lenten fasting tradition in this reflection. In addition, the giving of alms is one way to share God's gifts—not only through the distribution of money, but through the sharing of our time and talents. As St. John Chrysostom reminds us: "Not to enable the poor to share in our goods is to steal from them and deprive them of life. The goods we possess are not ours, but theirs." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2446).

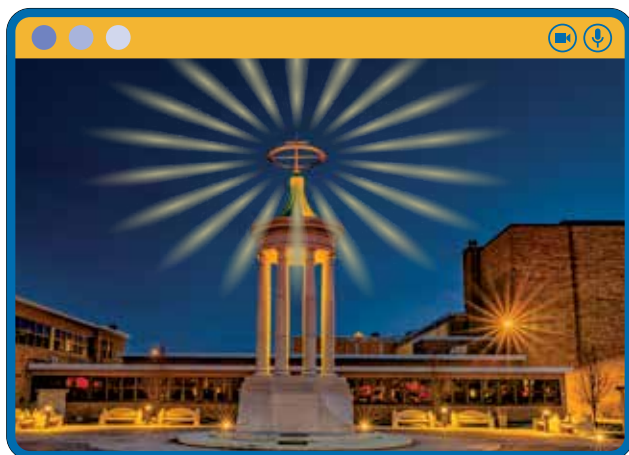
the USF Art Gallery on 25 E. Van Buren St., located in downtown Joliet.

JCA junior Alice Duncan-Abushalback lands lead role in “Beyond the Nutcracker” Ballet

JCA junior Alice Duncan-Abushalback was featured on the front cover of The Joliet Herald-News on December 16. Duncan-Abushalback, a Holy Family School, Shorewood graduate from Plainfield, landed the key role of Emma in Ballet 5:8’s holiday production of “Beyond the Nutcracker”.

Super surprised and happy.

That was the reaction from Alice Duncan, 16, of Plainfield, when she learned she would be playing the lead role in Ballet 5:8’s holiday production of “Beyond The Nutcracker.”

Duncan was especially astonished to land such a key role considering she had just joined Ballet 5:8 in August. But Benedict said Duncan had the skills that was needed for Emma: excellent core straight, strong point work and plenty of experience.

“We knew she’d be able to jump into the role quickly,” Benedict said.

Duncan said she began dancing at age 4 but it took a few years before she decided classical ballet was really her dance calling. Dancing was Duncan’s idea; her mother was hoping she’d become a gymnast, she said.

As a child, Duncan really didn’t understand why she was drawn to classical ballet.

“But now that I look back, I think it must have been the artistry,” Duncan said. “It’s so graceful and beautiful and you can tell stories through using your muscles and your body. It’s really a beautiful thing.”

Yet a great deal of work and stamina go into creating those graceful, beautiful performances. Physical fitness is important for dancers and emphasis is placed on developing strong core muscles, Duncan said.

Duncan takes classes every day except Sundays. She studies dance at Ballet 5:8 during the week and Plainfield Dance Academy, which Duncan has attended for years, on Saturdays.

She plans to continue dancing through college and hopes to make a career from dancing.

In addition to advancing her skills at Ballet 5:8, Duncan feels she’s learned something even more important than dance technique. And that’s how to develop a relationship with God.

Duncan said she’s always known about God. But knowing about God and knowing God are two different concepts, she said.

But at Ballet 5:8, Duncan has met many people whose lives are immersed with their love of God.

“It’s really opened a door for me,” Duncan said. “I love that because God and dance are two of my favorite things combined. It’s like chocolate and cake. “It’s so good.”

Athletic Roundup

COVID-19 wreaked havoc on our daily lives and the athletic seasons over the past year in Illinois. Spring 2020 sports were cancelled with the Angels and Hilltoppers returning impressive teams in girls soccer, softball, and baseball all with the potential to compete for IHSA state championships. Student-athletes did receive the opportunity to participate in summer and fall “contact days”. JCA Director of Admissions and Communications Ryan Quigley '03 said, “It’s not what anyone wanted, but I was impressed overall by the positive attitude our student-athletes had despite the challenges of potentially not being able to play. The work ethic and perseverance of these kids through the most adverse time of their lives shone through and has no doubt shaped their futures. They’ve led throughout this pandemic and they’ll continue to lead long after they leave JCA.”

The fall of 2020 saw “high-risk” contact sports like soccer, football, cheerleading, boys and girls basketball, and wrestling postponed. Non-contact sports like girls tennis, boys and girls golf, and cross-country all were able to hold athletic events in

the fall, absent a state tournament. Sports like girls tennis saw a record turnout as JCA students were motivated to try something new and get involved.

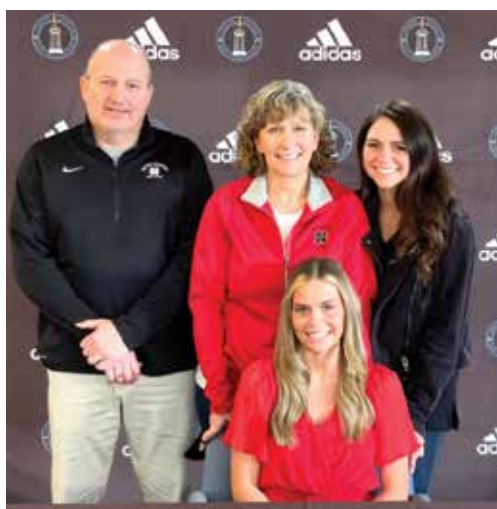

“Zy”, as she was known throughout the JCA community, was a shining light in the hallways at 1200 N. Larkin, and despite the challenges of losing her mother late in her high school career was flourishing as a freshman in college at Northern Illinois University. Zyane had recently completed the Young Visionaries College Prep Academy and was accepted by several universities and offered over \$100,000 in scholarships. After touring several schools, Zyane felt at home at Northern Illinois University and proudly made the decision to become a NIU Husky majoring in Business Management where she was destined to soar. Zyane's older brother, ZeVeyon Furcron, is a 2016 JCA graduate, and current member of the Southern Illinois University football team.

JCA English teacher Dr. Maria Fischer said, “The loss of Zyane Williams '20 was a tough one for several of us in the JCA family. We supported her when her mom passed, pursued scholarships to keep her at JCA, checked up on her school work and her mental health, tracked down the latest address for her senior yard sign as she had to move from family home to family home, and simply loved her. She will be missed.”

Fischer added, “But I've learned you get bitter or you get better. John Horn (JCA Director of Development) has explained the ins and outs of establishing a memorial scholarship for 8th grade African American girls who choose JCA. I feel this will not only honor Zyane's memory, but give another young lady the strength and support to be a part of the JCA family. We would like to start collecting funds to support this.”

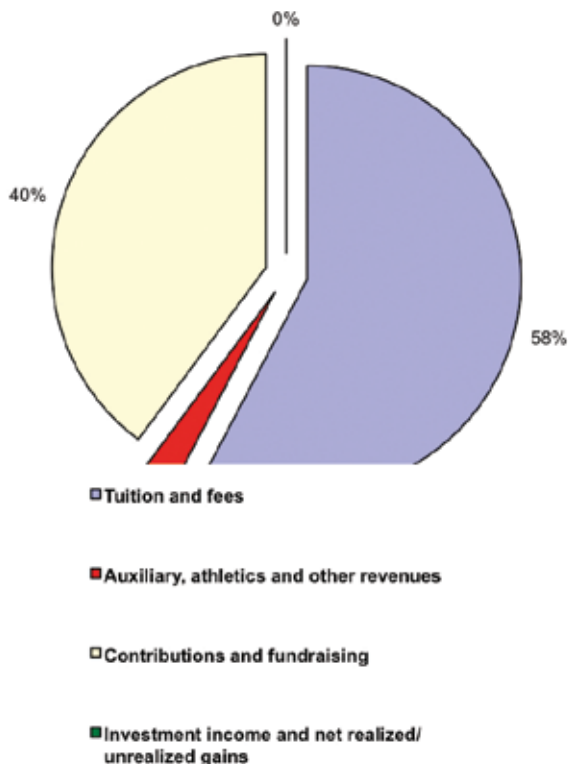

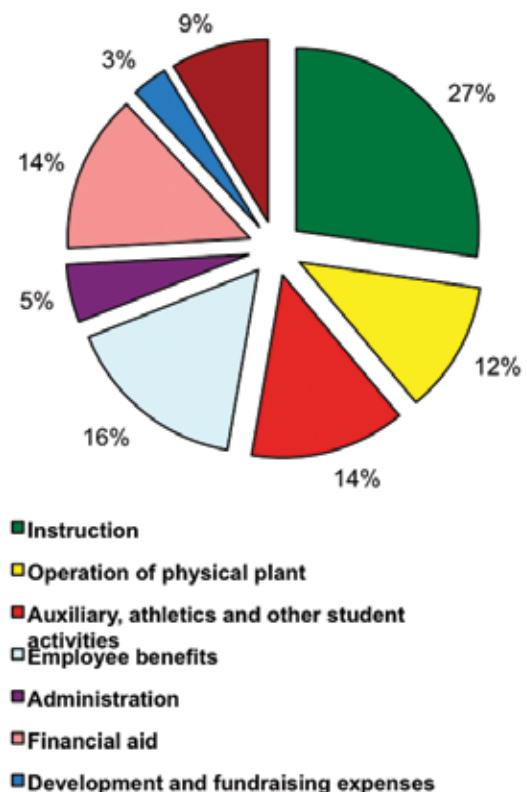
